



Rancho "Loma Alta" (2015)



Rancho "Loma Alta" [meaning 'high hill'] is about 1km east of Ocho's distillery, La Alteña. This ranch has an average of 2,047 meters altitude on a hill oriented south, planted in rows with an east-west orientation. The fertile red soil rich in iron and potassium provided an average 27% sugar content to the agaves.

Blanco [Plata]

Aroma - citrus, orange blossom, smoke, pumpkin, confectioners' sugar, spearmint, cured meat, cooked sweet potato, feral, aspirin, green olive, chlorophyll, shellfish minerality, salmi

Palate - grapefruit, menthol, tutti frutti, pepper, well integrated, balanced fruit and acidity, pineapple, spearmint, creamy, nutmeg, cinnamon, mezcal like



Reposado

Aroma - earth, burnt cassis, butterscotch, dates, stewed peaches, biscuit, wet woodland, straw

Palate - sweet cooked cranberry, marzipan, vanilla, crème brûlée, white pepper, passion fruit, antique wood, ends in bitter cacao
